

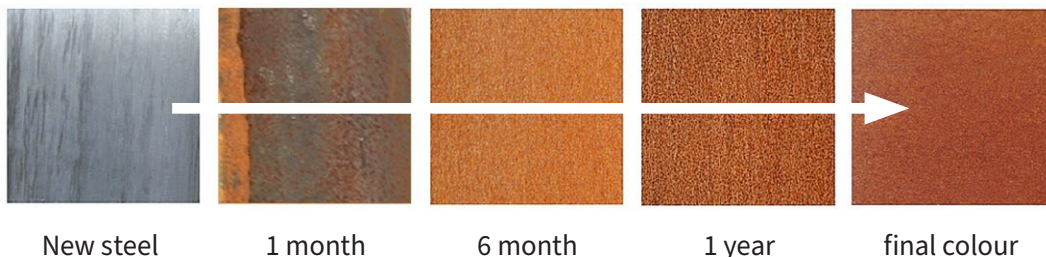


THE COLOUR EVOLUTION OF CORTEN STEEL

Corten steel, also known as weathering steel, is a durable type of steel that develops a rust-like patina when exposed to the elements. However, this rusting process is not destructive, but rather protective. It forms a stable, self-healing layer that prevents further corrosion, making corten steel extremely durable and suitable for outdoor environments.

Our corten steel fire bowls may arrive to you in various stages of rusting. The rusting process may have already started before the fire bowl is delivered. As a result, unevenness may already be present. Eventually, the fire bowl will take on a full rust colour.
